COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION (CSS) - 2007

The Federal Public Service Commission will hold the Competitive Examination 2007 for recruitment to posts in BS-17 under the Federal Government with effect from **24th March, 2007** simultaneously at the following centres:

EDUCATION

Candidates should have at least a Second Class Bachelor's Degree. A candidate who has obtained a third division or 'D' grade in his/her Bachelor's Degree will be eligible for the examination in cases where he/she has obtained a higher division in the Master's Degree. The result of the required educational qualification must have been declared on or before crucial date i.e. 1st July 2007.

AGE LIMITS

A candidate must have attained the age of twenty one (21) years and must not have attained the age of twenty eight (28) years on crucial date i.e. 1st July 2007. A candidate born earlier than 2nd July 1979 and later than 1st July 1986 will not be eligible.

AGE RELAXATION

The upper age limit will be relaxable by two years up to the age of thirty (30) years for the following category of the candidates:-

- (i) The candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and Buddhist community.
- (ii) The candidates who are permanent residents of AJK and Northern Areas or belonging to the recognized Tribes of Baluchistan, the Tribal Areas of D.I.Khan and Peshawar Divisions (including the former Frontier States of Dir, Swat, Chitral and Amb), former Tribal

Areas of Mardan and Hazara Divisions and Upper Tanawal Area of Hazara Division and former excluded (Baluch) area forming part of the D.G Khan and Rajanpur Districts.

- (iii) In the case of in service, Government servants/Contract employees including the AJK Government servants who have rendered not less than two years continuous Government Service on crucial date i.e. 1st July 2007.
- (iv) The candidates who are disabled namely, physically impaired, hearing/speech impaired (deaf & dumb) and visually impaired (blind).

DISABLED CANDIDATES

Disabled candidates are allowed to compete against four Occupational Groups/Services viz: (a) Commerce & Trade Group (b) Pakistan Audit & Accounts Service, (c) Information Group and (d) Postal Group, provided they fulfill the eligibility criteria of education and age limit as mentioned above.

NUMBER OF CHANCES

A Candidate who is otherwise eligible can avail maximum three chances.

VACANCIES

The number of vacancies to be filled on the basis of Examination, will be announced later.

EXAMINATION FEE

The fee Rs. 1000/- is to be deposited in the nearest Government Treasury or the State Bank of Pakistan or the National Bank of Pakistan, under the Head of Account "C-02101-Organs of State-Examination Fee Receipt of FPSC." Postal orders, cheques, money orders or Bank drafts will not be accepted.

ELIGIBILITY

Both Male & female candidates will be admitted to the examination provisionally at their own risk subject to their being found eligible in all respects. On detailed scrutiny of the applications after the written examination is over, if any candidate is found ineligible in any respect under the rules for the examination, his/her candidature will be cancelled regardless of the fact whether he/she has appeared in the examination or qualified therein.

NOTE

To avoid frustration, the candidates are advised in their own interest to make sure before appearing in the examination that they fulfill all the requirements of the rules, relating to the examination.
